## **Black-It Concentrated Solutions**

These instructions are for use by customers using Black-It solutions supplied in concentrated form.

To distinguish concentrated solutions from our standard pre-mixed ones there is always an additional label on the bottle.

Note: when diluting ALWAYS add the concentrated solution to the water – never the other way around.

The volumes quoted below can be scaled to suit the final volume required.

## Alkaline Degreaser (50%, 1:1)

The concentrated Alkaline Degreaser is easily recognised as it has a **RED** die in it.

Alkaline Degreaser is diluted to a 50% solution. Add one litre of the concentrated solution to one litre of water.

## **Conditioner (10%, 1:9)**

The concentrated Conditioner is easily recognised as it is a CLEAR solution.

Conditioner is diluted to a 10% solution. Add half a litre of the concentrated solution to 4.5 litres of water.

Note: To reduce frothing the solution should be added slowly down the edge of the container.

## **Blacking Solution (25%, 1:3)**

The Blacking Solution is easily recognised as it is a **BLUE** solution.

Blacking Solution is diluted to a 25% solution. Add one litre of the Blacking Solution to three litres of water.
